2008 PINOT NOIR OVERVIEW SHEET VINEYARD PHILOSOPHY

We source our fruit from highly sought after sites in the Anderson Valley, Sonoma Coast, Santa Barbara County and Russian River Valley appellations to create a range of regional wines that speak of the soil, the aspect and the viticulture of each area. We focus on small batch, premium quality Pinot Noir grapes from mature, cool-climate sites all along the burgeoning wine-growing regions of the California Coast. Working with unique sites farmed by the most experienced and quality focused viticultural teams in each region, we endeavor to achieve the true expression of each vineyard. All of the vineyards are sustainably farmed.



2008 RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

The color of this wine is striking: a deep rose hue with vibrant sapphire tinges. On the nose, fresh ripe strawberries meld with a subtle pie crust note with dried rose petals, lavender and cinnamon adding complexity. The palate delivers fresh strawberry fruit with a fine cranberry acid structure interlaced with extremely fine grained tannins leading to a long seamless finish. Our 2008 Russian River Pinot Noir was sourced from our West Pin Vineyard and the Crinella Vineyard.



2008 SONOMA COAST PINOT NOIR

The complex nature of this wine is indicated by its dark ruby color with blueberry hued edges. The aromatic profile is of dark forest undergrowth with black truffle essence, Bing cherry and blackberry bramble notes. The wine comes alive on the palate with dark boysenberry and blueberry notes filling out to a rich and finely grained mid palate with a fresh mineral acidity. The fresh black forest berry fruits are gently supported with subtle oak notes to carry the wine to a long, complex finish. Our 2008 Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir was sourced from McDougall Ranch, Putnam Vineyards, Gap's Crown and Rodgers Creek.



2008 ANDERSON VALLEY PINOT NOIR

The color of this wine is bright ruby with some darker blue and black hues. Aromas of fresh red raspberry and rose petal highlight the nose and are complexed by mineral notes. On the palate the wine has a fruit-sweet attack and oozes fresh red raspberries nuanced by minerality. The ripe berry fruits are bright on the mid-palate and subtle oak supports the fruit through to a long and slightly grainy finish redolent of red roses. Our 2008 Anderson Valley Pinot Noir was sourced from Ferrington Vineyard, Savoy Vineyard and Monument Tree Vineyard.



2008 SANTA BARBARA COUNTY PINOT NOIR

The purity of this wine is immediately evident in its bright, vibrant ruby color. It has a nose of fresh red rose petals with a mineral intensity and fruit that explodes from the glass with characters of black plum and blood orange zest. On the palate the sense of purity returns with a fruity attack, a full mid-palate of candied apple and plum supported by a lacy, acid backbone and nuanced oak. The palate evolves seamlessly to a long fine grained finish. The wine slowly unfolds and shows surprising complexity and incredible length of fruit and minerals. Our 2008 Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir was sourced from Bien Nacido Vineyard.
